Richard McGuire, 71, resigned as mayor after 1-1/2 years in office. He was a former Normal police chief and served as a Towanda village trustee for 5 years.

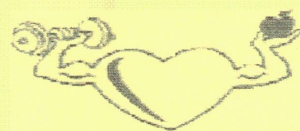
With the water tower project and the railroad crossing projects completed, Mr. McGuire said he's ready to take a break.
